## Regular Council meeting

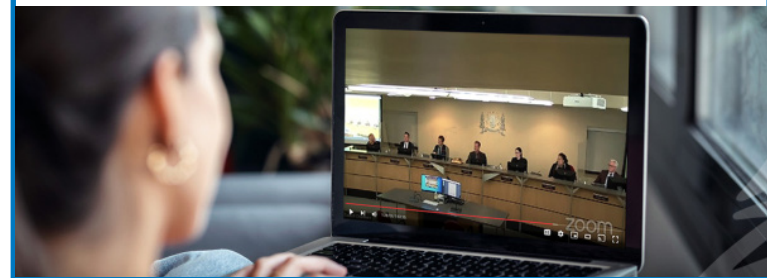
**Tuesday, October 11, 2022**
