Move your ramp, save a snow plow!

Residents who use curb ramps (also known as driveway ramps or driveway aids) are reminded that they must be removed from streets by November 1, as per Spruce Grove's Traffic Bylaw. Ramps can freeze to the road and get caught up in snow removal equipment, causing costly repairs and delays. Ramps may be placed on driveway curbs starting May 1. An important reminder for RV and boat owners
